Discussion

- Sherianne Hermes said there is pending federal legislation to change Telecommunicators to be reclassified as a Protective Service Occupation. She will send it out to the PAC.
- A question came up about FOID Card revocations. The Illinois State Police recently sent out a letter on the subject.
- Standard Updates—The following standard revisions in the Sixth Edition are coming up on a year since being revised. Make sure you are in compliance: 4.3.5 Firearms Range Policy; 35.1.8 Rater Evaluations. Standards 31.5.8 and 73.5.21 have been removed.
- Breath Alcohol Operator Recertification—Chris Fry said there have been some problems with the ISP transferring BAO certifications to ILEAS. In the next 1-2 months they will focus on getting expired officers recertified. The full migration to ILEAS will be done by the end of the summer. Eventually the HazMat training will also be switched to ILEAS.
