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Old Business

- By laws Update– Motion to approve the By Laws update was made by Katie Pentecost (Glendale Heights PD) (Motion seconded by Sherriane Hermes (ACDC). Motion Passed.
 - Updated Standards — 6 recent updates effective immediately. Dan Shaw clarified Vascular neck restraints is a “if” standard. Must train for the technique “if” your going to allow it. Continuous proofing (always will have 4 years of proofs) will start to be required this fall.
 - Other Old Business— none
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New Business

- Recent Mocks / onsite assessments / Annual CSM Reviews —
Cathy Nevara Hinsdale PD had a virtual assessment. Reviewed 100 standards instead of usual 80-88 standard review. Overall went well. Assessor was more attention oriented.

Rebecca Skinner UW Madison had 4th year annual assessment. Went smooth. Selected 130 standards to review. Assessor spot checked files that were not part of the 130 standards previously advised on.

Eric Brant Addison PD and Sherriane Hermes ACDC had their annual assessment. Great review. Went through several files that weren't on the standards to review. Assessors are going into the direction of these “spot checks”.

Bobby Broussard Buffalo Grove PD will have an assessment in October. The assessor advised BGPD the Assessor will be “spot checking” files not on the list

Jessica Ryan Normal PD had their year 3 review. Spot checked and assessment went great.

Dan Shaw (CALEA) Clarified assessors have been advised to “spot check” 25% of files. Agencies are now required to open all Power DMS files for assessment. This is to ensure agencies are keeping proofs up to date for four years and filling files.

New Business continued

- **HB5800/HB5810/HB5830**

HB5800—Excessive force. Attorney General will investigate not States Attorney.

HB5810— New Officers required to have a bachelors degree in social work. Tuition reimbursement for 2 years if qualified for financial aid.

HB5830— Collective Bargaining units will only pertain to wages or benefits. Officers will have CBU member present during interrogation.

Additional Bills in consideration;

HB5802—Defunding Police Departments

HB5805—Additional training for Use of Force Post Meeting Training

HB5807 No knock warrants are no longer allowed.

HB5809 Seek high school students who completed Police Training academy under the school code.

HB5814 POs are certified by ILESTSB instead of certified by the state.

HB5823 ban on federal military equipment to Agencies.

HB5826 Non-lethal force strategy.

HB5829 local records of police misconduct records can not be destroyed.

Post Meeting Training— No Training until we are back in person for meetings.

Other New Business

- CALEA conference—Will again be virtual and free. Must register for all classes prior in order to get credit for. Registration expected the end of October. November 10-13, 2020.
- Assessor requirements—CALEA is short on assessors and the exam is offered online on Power DMS.
- Virtual on-site assessments will continue to the end of the year 2020.
