Approval of Minutes

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Bolor Bat-Erdem (Elk Grove Village PD) report stating we have a starting balance of \$23,689.91 and an ending balance of \$20,942.37. We took in \$1,101.36 in membership dues, \$500 donation from the DuPage Chief's Association, and \$742.70 for the Holiday Luncheon. Our expenditures were \$5,091.60, for Skokie and Bensenville meeting reimbursements, Just Network renewal, IL SOS change of agent fee, Donation to Cmdr. Spanos family, Maggianos Holiday Luncheon, IPAC Conference Deposit, Quickbooks Subscription, Conference Flyer Reimbursement, and Amtrak membership dues reimbursement. Motion to approve was made by Stacy Blaskovich (Downers Grove PD), second by Ben Kadolph (Willowbrook PD). Motion passed.

Old Business

- Legislative Update: number of new ones in effect.
 - HB 1199 October is now Italian Heritage Month.
 - HB 1399 Creates the offense of lude sexual display in a penal institution. Does not define if this includes a police department holding facility.
 - HB 1540 Electronic Cigarettes added to 15ft prohibition of smoking from a door.
 - HB 2100 Can not financially exploit elderly, language changed to 70 years of age or older.
 - HB2123 Creating a cause for legal action against individuals who created digitally forged material with the intent to distribute and cause harm.
 - HB2223 Changed definition of delinquent minor, a minor who violates or attempts to violate State, Local or Municipal law, changed to any minor prior to the minor's eighteenth birthday has violated or attempted to violate in Illinois only, State, County, or Municipal Law.
 - HB2245 Cook County Only, establish a vehicle theft hotline.
 - HB2389 Prohibited for stopping a person for hanging mirror violation.
 - HB2431 Illegal to use video conferencing or social media while driving.
 - HB2562 Housing occupants are 55+ years old, building serves a population of 55+ guidelines for temperatures during certain times of the year.
 - HB3304 Prosecution for fraud related to COVID-19
 - HB3326 Prohibits use of Automated LPR using that data to interfere with a persons right to lawful healthcare service, including reproductive health or permits detention of a person based on immigration status.
 - HB3396 Illegal to place anything in the public right of way to impede a picket or protest.
 - HB3751 If you can legally work in the U.S. you can apply to be a police officer, not required to be a citizen.
 - SB896 permits motorcycles to add additional fancy lights.
 - SB1543 Create Statewide Mental Health Coordinator position.
 - SB1754 Agencies wishing to waive training, lateral officers from another state, making it easier.
- 5ILCS100/5-45.35
 - Drivers Ed is adding how to being a stranded motorist into the rules of the road.
 - HB4339 50ILCS205/30 amends local records act, provides that a law enforcement agencies that encrypt radio transmissions make those transmissions available to media outlets in real time. Proposed, DuPage County ETSB has this on their radar.
- IPAC Conferenc: venue Doubletree Oakbrook, bring training topics to the committee. If paying via invoice, send an email to Bolar so it is processed in time. ILEAP certification, Therapy Dogs, Skokie Co-Responder Model, Human Trafficking, PowerDMS and more.
- Scholarship: Applications due Feb 14th submit for ILEAP or CALEA agencies, numerous ways to use it.

 - Removed 5 agencies for non payment.
 - Ben Kadolph (Willowbrook PD) - CALEA agency on-sites, no more public hearing or phone in sessions. Get positive comments through your portal. This is an opportunity to have comments that focus on your areas of interest.

New Business

- Recent Mocks/On-Sites (ILEAP and CALEA)/Annual CSM Reviews
 - UW Whitewater had a mock in early December, they wanted to thank everyone and are working on their policies.
 - Lake Zurich on-site went well Assessor Vincent Demaio, previously had a standards issue for continuity of operations, Dan Shaw suggested an interview topic that it would have fallen under so that the assessor would be looking at it again and be able to put it into compliance. They did that and Vincent advised it should be good and he doesn't see any issues.
 - Skokie had an on-site, 1 day assessment, assessor was Joel, had no calls for phone in session he urged them to publicize more next time.
 - Carpentersville received their ILEAP Accreditation Letter.
 - Glendale Heights is in the middle of their year two CSM review.
 - Elk Grove Village CSM Russ McElwee, agency was able to choose all 4 of their topics of focus, Use of Force/Internal Affairs, Evidence/Property Control, Citizen Complaints and Traffic. 7 issues, he was asking for actual date the CALEA Portal went live. 21.2.2 who is responsible for review, who reviews job description.
 - Willowbrook had CSM Russ McElwee, still wanted date on the portal, Ben provided a screen shot of the date it was published. Minor issues, but nothing out of compliance.
 - Hanover Park, year 3 newer assessor, Tonya Perry, had issues with time zone differences. She missed 2 scheduled interviews and called at the wrong time for exit interview.
- Other new business:
 - Sherianne Hermes (ACDC) mono snap is a free app for screen shot and you can mark the information in the app.
 - Sherianne Hermes (ACDC) Congratulations received her Certified Accreditation Manager Award.
 - Joliet Junior College new membership, Tracy Williams. Motion for new member JJC made by Robert Zielinski (Niles PD), 2nd Ben Kadolph (Willowbrook PD). Motion passed, Welcome Joliet Junior College.
